Its rimless, antimicrobial design eliminates 99.99% of surface bacteria. Evac Optima 7 represents the next evolution in onboard sanitation - uniting modern engineering with timeless Nordic design.

Optima 7 is designed to meet the needs of cruise ships, and is equally well-suited for other passenger vessels, ferries, and yachts, offering the performance, reliability, and sustainability that maritime operators require.

Jari-Petri Voutilainen, Senior Designer at Pentagon Design said, "When we began this project, the goal was simple: to blend cutting-edge vacuum technology with timeless Nordic design. Winning two Red Dot Awards confirms our belief that great design should not only elevate user experience but also contribute to a more sustainable world."

For Evac, the product reflects decades of expertise, with over 1 million vacuum toilets delivered since 1979. Optima 7 was engineered to meet the rising demands for water-saving, easy-to-maintain, and hygienic solutions - using only **1.2 liters of freshwater per flush**.

We were introducing a flagship - one that delivers quiet comfort, antimicrobial protection, effortless installation, and a modern aesthetic. It's everything our customers value, built into one seamless experience."
