

Data Act – Information on the Product Data

Under European Union Regulation (EU) 2023/2854 (the "EU Data Act"), in accordance with Article 3.2 of the EU Data Act, Evac informs the customer that the Products:

collect and utilize product data as follows:

The type, format and estimated volume of product data which the connected product is capable of generating	ICCP system readings are logged within the panel. Output current, output voltage, reference electrode values and any alarm status are logged. Readings can be stored between 1-to-24-hour intervals.
Whether the connected product is capable of generating data continuously and in real-time;	Readings can be stored between 1-to-24-hour intervals, this is configurable with the control panel.
Whether the connected product is capable of storing data on-device or on a remote server, including, where applicable, the intended duration of retention;	The data logging capabilities of the control panel are not connected to a remote server.
How the user may access, retrieve or, where relevant, erase the data, including the technical means to do so, as well as their terms of use and quality of service	System readings can be uploaded to a USB flash drive.
